All participants attending the Spring REM agree to the following expectations:

- REM participants will attend all scheduled REM activities: 18 hours of workshop instruction and 16 hours of structured social, physical and emotional health activities
- REM participants will behave respectfully towards each other, session leaders and REM volunteers. Respect includes:
  - The use of appropriate language
  - Following directions from session leaders and REM organizers
  - Caring for REM and school property
  - Being mindful/ respectful to others
- REM participants will arrive on time for scheduled sessions. If a participant is unable to meet this requirement (ie. illness) they must notify their school chaperone immediately.
- REM participants, when moving between the Community Center and school grounds, will travel in small groups and with their chaperone or session leader to their destination.
- REM participants who fail to meet the expectations above will have a behavior meeting in consultation with school chaperones, school principal and the Area 3 Superintendent, Greg Storey.
- A REM participant will be sent home, at the parent/guardians expense, if they engage in following behaviours: **initials** \_\_\_\_\_
  - Repeated refusal to follow direction
  - Any act of violence against another individual
  - Any use of alcohol or illegal drugs
  - Any sexual contact
  - Other serious infractions
